AMENDMENT OF CERTIFICATION

1 The suffix has been added for record keeping purposes to distinguish the two certifications issued in this single case.

Pursuant to Section 2422.1 of the Regulations of the Federal Labor Relations Authority, a petition was filed seeking to amend the recognition granted in 1965 and most recently clarified in Case No. AT-RP-04-0051 to the **American Federation of Government Employees, Local 1815, AFL-CIO**, as the exclusive representative of employees of the United States Army Aviation Warfighting Center [formerly the United States Department of the Army, United States Army Aviation Center, Fort Rucker, Alabama] and other listed Agencies not affected by this reorganization by changing the designation of the Agency for certain employees of the bargaining unit who transferred from the **United States Army Aviation Warfighting Center** to the **United States Department of the Army, U.S. Army Air Traffic Services Command, Fort Rucker, Alabama**.

On December 22, 2005, I issued a Decision and Order finding that the recognition may be amended as requested. The parties waived their right to file an Application for Review. Pursuant to the authority vested in me as Regional Director,

I ORDER that the recognition granted in 1965 and as most recently clarified in Case No. AT-RP-04-0051 for the **American Federation of Government Employees, Local 1815, AFL-CIO**, as the exclusive representative of the following the consolidated unit of general schedule employees represented be amended to reflect the addition of **U.S. Army Air Traffic Services Command, Fort Rucker, Alabama**, to the list of Agencies for which the Exclusive Representative holds exclusive recognition.

INCLUDED:

All nonprofessional nonsupervisory General Schedule employees at the U.S. Combat Readiness Center, all professional and nonprofessional nonsupervisory General Schedule employees of the U.S. Army Aviation Warfighting Center and Fort Rucker, the United States Army Aeromedical Center, the United States Army Dental Command; the U.S. Army Aviation Technical Test Center, the U.S. Army Installation Management Agency (IMA); the U.S. Army Contracting Agency (ACA); and the U.S. Army Air Traffic Services Command, Fort Rucker, Alabama.

EXCLUDED:

All employees assigned to other tenant activities, guards, temporary employees, professional employees of the U.S. Army Combat Readiness Center, the Aerospace Engineering Technician GS-0802-7/8/9 position assigned to the Army Aviation Technical Test Center (ATTC) Test Support Directorate (TSD), and employees defined in 5 U.S.C. 7112(b)(2), (3), (4), (6) and (7).
