Law Enforcement:

Crime Prevention Tips During the Holidays.

- Don't advertise...burglars look for occupancy cues like outdoor lights burning 24 hours a day, newspapers not picked up, mail hanging on door knobs.
- After Christmas, don't pile up empty boxes from expensive gifts on the street to serve as clues for burglars. Haul boxes off yourself or cut them up to conceal the previous contents.

Fire Safety:

Use of Turkey Fryers. Frying turkeys during Thanksgiving has become very popular but is extremely hazardous as there is a open flame and a large pot filled with boiling oil. Please follow all instructions provided with the turkey fryer. If the instructions are lost please go online and print out new instructions. Follow some simple but important rules when frying a turkey or using the fryer.

- Turkey fryers should always be used outdoors a safe distance from buildings and any other material that can burn. Never use turkey fryers on wooden decks or in garages.
- Make sure the fryers are used on a flat surface to reduce accidental tipping. Never leave the fryer unattended.
- Never let children or pets near the fryer when in use. Even after use, never allow children or pets near the turkey fryer. The oil inside the cooking pot can remain dangerously hot, hours after use. To avoid oil spillover, do not overfill the fryer.
- Use well-insulated potholders or oven mitts when touching pot or lid handles. If possible, wear safety goggles to protect your eyes from oil splatter. Make sure the turkey is completely thawed and be careful with marinades. Oil and water don't mix, and water causes oil to spill over, causing a fire or even an explosion hazard.

- Keep an all-purpose fire extinguisher nearby. Never use water to extinguish a grease fire. Remember to use your best judgment when attempting to fight a fire. If the fire is manageable, use an all-purpose fire extinguisher. If the fire increases, immediately call 9-1-1 for help.
- Follow manufacture directions when filling the pot with oil. To determine how much oil you'll need, put the turkey in the basket and place in the pot. Add water until it reaches one to two inches above the turkey. Lift the turkey out, and use a ruler to measure the distance from the water to the top of the fryer. Pour out the water and dry the fryer completely. Remember that it can take anywhere from 20 minutes to an hour to heat the oil, depending on the outside temperature, wind and weather.
- Before frying, pat the turkey dry with paper towels to keep the hot oil from spattering and popping. Slowly lower the turkey into the oil, and maintain an oil temp of 350° F. Oil can ignite at 375° F. Fry turkey for three to four minutes per pound or about 35 to 42 minutes for a 10- to 12-pound turkey.
- Make sure the turkey is thawed and dry before immersing in the hot oil. Make sure you have help as necessary and the proper tools for lowering the turkey into the fryer. Be extremely careful during this procedure.
